Apply for Pupil Premium funding (also known as Free School Meals, FSM): All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 automatically get universal free school meals. However, if you receive certain benefits, you are encouraged to apply for free school meals when you enrol at school, as this can help schools to attract additional Pupil Premium funding to support learning. If you are eligible for Pupil Premium funding, it will also give you access to food voucher codes at all supermarkets, £15 per week per child over holiday periods, and completely free childcare during holiday periods through HAF programmes (these happen all over Exeter and currently there is one running at Westbank during holiday periods).
